

Only you can determine the best self-recovery/escape plan for your hunting situation, and you must have a self-recovery/escape plan for your individual situation before leaving the ground. There is time to make a correct decision on what action to take if a fall occurs while wearing a full-body fall arrest harness. It is important to remember, "DO NOT PANIC." You must only hunt from the ground when self-recovery/escape ability is absent. Failure to follow these instructions may result in serious injury or death!

WARNING! A suspension relief device must be on your person and readily accessible while using a harness. These devices allow



the user to relieve the load on the lower extremities if suspended in a harness and help maintain circulation in the legs, mitigate suspension trauma (blood pooling) or allow descent to the ground. CLIMBING AIDS FOR HANG-ON TREESTANDS



A full body harness with a lineman's/climbing belt must be worn at all times while installing or removing any hang-on climbing aids



Hang-on climbing aids must be placed on the tree at a height above the platform where the user can maintain a handhold on the unit and step downwards onto the treestand. Never step up from a climbing device to get into your stand.




When using a climbing/lineman's belt to ascend the tree, the full body harness shall be attached to the tree before stepping down onto the treestand.



Sectional ladders and steps shall be spaced on the tree to ensure each step is no more than 18 in. (45.72) apart



Check every stick ladder section connection every time you use the stick ladder before you leave the ground. If stick ladder sections are separating, do not use the stick ladder.



Setup with Pull Strap.

1.) Rotate steps 90 degrees to lock in securely. Be sure to make ridged side face the top of the stick (pictured)






Step 2.) Next, rotate standoff 90 degrees so that it is parallel to the step and tighten knob clockwise.



Step 3.) Place stick firmly against the tree in your desired location (make sure standoffs are firmly seated against the tree) while placing the short end of strap around attachment button



Step 4.) While holding stick in desired place, wrap the long end of the pull strap around the tree



Step 5.) Once the long end of the strap is around the tree, place the looped end around the attachment button.



Step 6.) Pull strap tight.



Step 7.) Once you believe to have the strap tight, make sure that the standoffs have four points of contact against the tree.




Step 8.) Pull firmly downward on the top step to allow strap to tighten.



Setup Instructions with a Mini Strap tied

Step 1.) Loop end of strap around button post







Step 3.) Wrap Strap over top of button post, then behind strap on opposite side.



Step 4.) Pull tag end under opposite side strap, under button post, in front of stick post. Then pull tight



Step 5.) Tie two half hitches
